Modeling the inside of a tunnel

New *MRH* forum member **voluse** (Verl L.) recently asked fascia-how to model the inside of a tunnel. One answer gives the way to model a long tunnel so it's exposed along the fascia [3].

Other forum members chimed in with many helpful posts. This one from VSOTTO was quite clever:

"Presumably the track inside the tunnel would be very close to the fascia edge. If I were building this project, I would build the tunnel portal at the wide/normal width of the benchwork and then transition to a narrow shelf portion showing the interior of the tunnel. I got inspired, and drew a mock up of how I envision it. I would also cover the interior tunnel portion with a removable piece of plexi-glass (which isn't shown) to prevent derailed trains from falling to the floor."
